Post #1 - *Frustrated with OSCAR's User Interface? We've got a solution.*

### Q1 -

*"I'm not really feeling it, it just seems to add a new look without streamlining the functionality. Personally, I'd like to see a reorganization of capacity, seats remaining, etc. to make it look better." - zxcv643*

*"In a dream world, I'd love to see a lot of the columns removed to emphasize the capacity, seats remaining, etc. columns. For example, displaying "CS 1301" and the number of credit hours can just be displayed at the top of the page, which would already remove 3 columns. Days and times can be moved to the right of the waitlist information so they're just to the right of the instructor and out of the way. Also, it's really annoying to actually get to the class pages, with you first having to select the term, the subject, and then the class. It would be helpful if this could be done with a search bar, where you would just type in "CS 1301" for example and the latest semester would be the first option. Obviously, I understand that you're limited, but these are just my thoughts. Thanks for taking the time to improve our archaic system of class registration, any innovation is welcomed!" - zxcv643*

It's a good idea to not only focus on the visual aesthetics but also the overall user flow + functionality of the site. How could we lower the number of screens a user is presented with? How can the user achieve their intended outcome in the most intuitive + streamlined way? I think the answer could lie with consolidating OSCAR's numerous pages into single ones with more intuitive ways to do common things (i.e register class, look up class).
